THE EVENT

This is an open-air event. We advise customers to wear appropriate footwear and to bring a jacket / warm layer as the evenings can get chilly and the performance will go ahead come rain or shine.

ORDER OF EVENTS

- A Pop-up Box Office will be open from 4:00pm at the castle main entrance where your tickets can be exchanged for wristbands.
- Doors/Gates will open at 6.30pm and refreshments will be available on site from this time.
- The performance will begin at approximately 7.30pm
- There will be an interval between the performances of approximately 30 minutes
- In line with our licensing curfew this show will end by 11pm.

PRICE

£25. Tickets may be available on the door, but this is strictly subject to availability. Cash sales only on the door (cash machines are available nearby on Cardigan High Street). We advise booking in advance to avoid disappointment.

PARKING

• Please note that there is NO ON-SITE PARKING at Cardigan Castle, and we advise customers to use the public pay & display carparks (free after 6pm) situated around the town.

INFORMATION FOR OUR DISABLED CUSTOMERS

- We will be providing a seating area for wheelchair users and their companions.
- There is level access to the site for wheelchair users, and there will be designated members of staff on hand to assist and direct you to your reserved seating. Please come to the main entrance point marked on the map below where you will be met by a member of our duty team.
- PLEASE NOTE If you have already booked your tickets <u>but have not yet advised us of any special seating requirements</u> please do so immediately via our box office on 01239 621 200 or by emailing boxoffice@mwldan.co.uk. We cannot guarantee that there will be sufficient space on the night for those who have not advised us in advance of any special seating requirements.

SEATING

 No seating is provided at this event. Customers are welcome to bring foldable low-backed camping chairs with them to this event.

TICKETS & ENTRY TO THE SITE

Entry to the site for ticket holders is via the main castle entrance marked on the map.

- A Pop-up Box Office will be open from 4:00pm at the castle main entrance where your tickets can be exchanged for wristbands on the day (you will not be able to collect your wristbands from Mwldan in advance). Please collect your wristbands early to help us keep queuing to a minimum.
- To get your wristband at the castle you can either:
 - Show your QR booking code on your mobile phone
 - Exchange your physical ticket from Mwldan
 - Show your ticket printout if you have booked online
- NO TICKET, NO ENTRY. We reserve the right to request a form of ID to verify that you are the booker, or in the event of needing to clarify eligibility for a concessionary price (where applicable).
- We will be unable to reprint tickets if lost or misplaced. Please contact Mwldan's box office if you are unable to print your own ticket and we will print it for you.
- Tickets for these shows are sold on an non-refundable basis.

FOOD AND DRINK

- Food and Drink purchased outside of the Castle grounds will not be permitted on site at this event. Any food or drink being brought onto site will be confiscated and not returned.
- You are welcome to bring an empty water bottle onto site, which you can refill at the Pavilion Bar.
- A bar and food will be available for refreshments on site. The food offering will include vegetarian and vegan options.
