

ADWAITH

Genre: Post-punk
Genre: Ôl-pync

Yn hanu o Gaerfyrdin ac wedi'u meithrin gan sîn indie-rock Gymraeg fywiog, Adwaith yw'r unig artistiaid sydd wedi ennill y Gwobr Gerddoriaeth Gymreig fawreddog ddwywaith – a hynny gyda'u dau albwm cyntaf. Gan dreiddio i mewn i ôl-pync afluniedig, penrhyydd ac wedi'u hysbrydoli gan fandiau arbrofol eofn (gan gynnwys Datblygu o Aberteifi), fe wnaeth albwm cyntaf Adwaith, 'Melyn' (2016) gipio'r ymdeimlad o ranbarth wedi'i ymylu a'i anwybyddu gan San Steffan. Maen nhw wedi cefnogi IDLES a'r Manics, ac maen nhw'n mynd â'r Gymraeg ar daith ryngwladol sy'n chwalu ffiniau'n ddi-ben-draw.

Emerging from Carmarthen and nurtured by a vibrant Welsh-language indie-rock scene, Adwaith are the only artists to have won the prestigious Welsh Music Prize twice - and that with their first two album releases. Delving into mangled, free-wheeling post-punk and inspired by boldly experimental bands (including Aberteifi's very own Datblygu), Adwaith's debut 'Melyn' (2016) captured the sense of a region sidelined and ignored by Westminster. They've supported IDLES and the Manics, and are taking the Welsh language on an international border-busting trip that knows no boundaries.



CERYS HAFANA

Genre: Alt-folk, Experimental folk, Contemporary folk, New composition, Welsh folk
Genre: Gwerin-amgen, Gwerin Arbrofol, Gwerin-cyfoes, Cyfansoddi newydd, Gwerin Cymraeg

Cyfansoddwraig ac aml-offerynwraig yw Cerys Hafana sy'n manglo, ail-lunio a thrawsnewid cerddoriaeth draddodiadol. Mae ei cherddoriaeth yn chwarae gyda phosibiliadau unigryw'r delyn deires, yn ogystal â seiniau hapgael, deunyddiau archifol a phrosesu electronig. Mae'n hanu o Fachynlleth, Cymru, lle mae afonydd a ffyrdd yn cwrdd ar y ffordd i'r môr. Rhyddhawyd 'Edyf', ei hail albwm, yn 2022, a chafodd ei ddewis fel un o Ddeg Albwm Gwerin Gorau 2022 gan y Guardian ac mae wedi cyrraedd rhestr fer Albwm Cymraeg y Flwyddyn 2023. Cerys Hafana is a composer/multi-instrumentalist who mangles, mutates and transforms traditional music. She explores the creative possibilities and unique qualities of the triple harp, as well as found sounds, archival materials and electronic processing. She comes from Machynlleth, Wales, where rivers and roads meet on the way to the sea. 'Edyf', her second album, released in 2022, was selected as one of The Guardian's Top Ten folk albums of 2022 and is on the shortlist for the Welsh Language Album Of The Year in 2023.



COLM MAC CON IOMAIRE

Brodor o Ddulyn yw Colm sy'n byw yn Wexford. Mae'n feiolinydd ac yn cyfansoddi ar gyfer offerynnau niferus. Enillodd ei sgôr ffilm ddiweddar ar gyfer y ffilm nodwedd Wyddelig 'Roise & Frank' Wobr y Gynulleidfa Santa Barbara 2022. Mae Colm yn cyfansoddi ar gyfer ffilmiau nodwedd, dawns gyfoes, animeiddiadau ac mae hefyd wedi bod yn ysgrifennu cerddoriaeth ar gyfer Teledu a Theatr ers degawd. Mae ei gerddoriaeth wedi bod yn rhan o Blue Planet gan David Attenborough, Sky Arts, Wild Ireland a ffilmiau byr animeiddiedig ar gyfer Cartoon Saloon ('Late Afternoon') a enillodd Wyl Ffilm Tribeca 2018 a chafodd ei henwebu am Oscar. Colm is a Dublin native living in Wexford. A violinist and multi-instrumentalist composer, his recent film score for the Irish feature film 'Roise & Frank' won the 2022 Santa Barbara Audience Award. Colm writes for feature film, contemporary dance, animation and has also been writing music for television and theatre for a decade. His music has been part of David Attenborough's Blue Planet, Sky Arts, Wild Ireland and animation shorts for Cartoon Saloon ('Late Afternoon') which won the 2018 Tribeca Film Festival and Oscar nominated.



KING CREOSOTE

Genre: Indie, Folk Indie , Pop Alternative/Indie, Rock

Genre: Indi, Indi-Gwerin, Pop-amgen / Indi, Roc

Ers ail hanner y 1990au, mae hunaniaeth-arall DIY pop Kenny Anderson, sef King Creosote, wedi rhyddhau dros 100 o recordiau. Mae ei ganeuon wedi cael eu hail-berfformio gan artistiaid eraill sy'n cynnwys Simple Minds a Patti Smith. Gwaith diweddaraf King Creosote gan Anderson yw 'I DES', albwm sy'n parhau â'i ymgais i lywio marwoldeb, angerdd, dyfroedd stormus, y lleuad yn yr awyr, ac East Neuk yn Fife. Boed yn chwarae gitâr, banjo, accordion, neu syntheseiddydd modiwlaid, yr elfennau cyffredin yw llais unigryw KC, a'i ganeuon swynol, chwareus, crwydrol, sy'n datblygu'n barhaus, yng nghyhwair Fife.

Since the mid-late 1990s, Kenny Anderson's DIY pop alter-ego King Creosote has released over 100 records. His songs have been covered and performed by artists including Simple Minds and Patti Smith. Anderson's latest King Creosote outing is 'I DES', an album that continues his quest to navigate mortality, ardour, stormy waters, the moon in the sky, and the East Neuk of Fife. Whether playing guitar, banjo, accordion, modular synths or wine glass drones, the common threads are KC's singular voice, and his roguish, roving, ever-evolving, gorgeous songs in the key of Fife.



SANS SOUCIS

Genre: Alt-pop, Electronic

Genre: Pop-amgen, Electronig

Mae Sans Soucis (hi/nhw) yn gwneud cerddoriaeth sy'n bywiogi'r enaid. Mae cerddoriaeth Sans Soucis yn weithred radical o adenill sy'n deillio o'r awydd i ailgysylltu â llawenydd a didwylledd penrhyyd plentyndod a gollir gennym i gyd wrth i ni heneiddio. Yn rhudd o gyfyngiadau genre a gydag ystod eang o feini prawf sonig – o electroneg ysgogol Little Dragon, R&B-amgen Solange Knowles, ymwl emosiynol Joni Mitchell ac alawon pop cadarn Rihanna – mae byd Sans Soucis yn un sy'n gorlifo â gweadau cerddorol bywiog, geiriau perthnasol a dos adfywiol o baith.

Sans Soucis (she/they) makes music that invigorates the soul. Born out of a desire to reconnect with the uninhibited joyfulness and authenticity of childhood that we lose as we grow older, their music is a radical act of reclamation. Free from the constraints of genre and with a wide gamut of sonic touchstones – from the effervescent electronics of Little Dragon, Solange Knowles's alt-R&B, the emotional edge of Joni Mitchell and the robust pop melodies of Rihanna – Sans Soucis' world is one overflowing with vibrant musical textures pertinent lyrics and refreshing dose of hopefulness.



SUSAN O'NEILL

Genre: Alternative, Folk

Genre: Amgen, Gwerin

Mae Susan wedi treulio'r ychydig flynyddoedd diwethaf yn mireinio ei chrefft fel perfformwraig unigol. A hithau'n gyfansoddwraig hynod alluog, gyda llais bythol sydd yr un mor lleddfol ag y mae'n nerthol, mae hi'n fentrus tu hwnt, yn ysbryd rhydd; perfformwraig go iawn. Ar gyfer 'In The Game', ei halbwym ar y cyd â Mick Flannery, fe gafodd Susan ei henwebu am Wobr Choice Music a Gwobrau Gwerin RTÉ Radio 1 ar gyfer 'Albwym y Flwyddyn', 'Artist Gwerin Benywaidd' y Flwyddyn, ac yn ogystal, fe enillodd hi wobr y Trac Gwerin Gwreiddiol Gorau ar gyfer y gân ar y cyd 'Chain Reaction'. Yn y pen draw, yr albwm ar y cyd oedd yr albwm annibynnol **Gwyddelig a werthodd fwyaſ yn 2021**.

A songwriter of hidden depths, Ireland's Susan O'Neill has a timeless voice that is equal parts balm and blowtorch, she is audacity personified, a free spirit; a real performer. 'In The Game', her collaboration album with Mick Flannery, saw her receive nominations for the Choice Music prize and the RTÉ Radio 1 Folk Awards for 'Album of the Year', 'Female Folk Artist' of the Year, and take home the Best Original Folk Track award for the collaborative song 'Chain Reaction'. Their collaborative album was the biggest selling Irish independent record of 2021.



THE JOY FORMIDABLE

Genre: Indie rock, Alternative rock, Indie pop, Post-punk, Art rock, Rock
Genre: Roc Indi, Roc-amgen, Pop Indi, Ôl-pync, Roc Celf, Roc

Mae gan y rocwyr indi The Joy Formidable yrfa sy'n ymestyn dros un mlynedd ar bymtheg a phum albwm. Yn hanu o'r Wyddgrug, ond yn rhychwantu'r byd, maen nhw'n byw ar hyn o bryd yn Utah ac wedi teithio gyda grwpiau fel y Foo Fighters a Muse. Mae Ritz Bryan (canu, gitâr), Rhydian Dafydd (bas, BVs), a Matt Thomas (drymiau) yn cyflwyno roc cyntefig "sy'n feiddgar o felodaidd" a "brys gwallgo".

With a career spanning sixteen years and five albums, indie rockers The Joy Formidable come from Mold yet span the global, currently residing in Utah and having toured with the likes of Foo Fighters and Muse. Ritz Bryan (vocals, guitar), Rhydian Dafydd (bass, BVs), and Matt Thomas (drums) deliver primal "riotously melodic" rock and "feverish immediacy".



YARD ACT

Genre: Indie, Rock, Electronica, Post-Punk
Genre: Indi, Roc, Electroniq, Ôl-pync

Yn y tair blynedd ers i sengl gyntaf Yard Act gael ei rhyddhau, yn gyflym iawn maen nhw wedi tyfu'n un o fandiau pwysicaf Prydain ar hyn o bryd. Wedi'u henwebu am Wobr Mercury ar gyfer eu halbwym cyntaf gwefreiddiol 'The Overload' (2022), mae'r band pedwar aelod hwn o Leeds wedi ymosod ar realiti dinistriol cyfalafiaeth, trachwant a braint mewn modd cyffrous, gan reidio'r don newydd o ôl-bync gyda geiriau brathog sydd hefyd yn llawn hiwmor, crafster, a thosturi. Ateb ysbrydoledig i'r "once unstoppable isle" sef y DU yn 2023.

In just three years since Yard Act's first single dropped, they have quickly become one of the most essential British bands of the moment. Mercury-nominated for their thrilling debut album 'The Overload' (2022), this four piece from Leeds have laid into the destructive realities of capitalism, greed and privilege in riveting style, riding the new wave of post-punk with biting lyrics that are also full of humour, insight, and compassion. An inspiring antidote to the "once unstoppable isle" that is the UK, 2023.



ALFFA

Genre: Rock, Punk, Blues, Hard Rock
Genre: Roc, Pync, Blues, Roc Caled

Grŵp roc o Gymru yw Alffa a ffurfiwyd gan y ddeuawd ddawnus Dion Jones (Gitâr) a Siôn Land (Drymiau). Mae nhw'n adnabyddus am eu perfformiadau byw gwefreiddiol a'u hegni di-ffrwyn. Gyda nifer cynyddol o ddilynwyr ar-lein a theithiau llwyddiannus ar hyd a lled y Deyrnas Unedig, mae'r band yn gwneud enw i'w hunain fel un o'r actau mwyaf cyffrous sy'n dod i'r amlwg yn y diwydiant. Mae cerddoriaeth Alffa, sy'n tynnu ysbrydoliaeth o genres roc trwm, yn cyfuno seinweddau pwerus gyda storïa emosiynol, gan swyno gwrandawyr ledled y byd.

Formed by the talented duo of Dion Jones (Guitar) and Siôn Land (Drums), Alffa is a Welsh rock sensation known for their electrifying live performances and raw energy. With a growing online following and successful tours across the United Kingdom, the band is making a name for themselves as one of the most exciting emerging acts in the industry. Drawing inspiration from heavy rock genres, Alffa's music combines powerful soundscapes with emotive storytelling, captivating listeners worldwide.



AMY MICHELLE

Genres: Alternative, Indie, Singer Songwriter
Genres: Amgen, Indi, Cantores-gyfansoddwraig

Cantores-gyfansoddwraig o Mullingar yng nghanolbarth Iwerddon yw amy michelle. Fe ddaeth ei chyfansoddi caneuon hynod bersonol a'i llais syfrdanol at sylw glustiau'r diwydiant drwy demos a gynhyrchwyd ganddi ar soundcloud yn 2021. Ers hynny, mae amy wedi rhyddhau dau EP anhygoel, drwy'r label recordiau Prydeinig, Method, ac mae ill dau wedi derbyn canmoliaeth eang gan Clash, The Line Of Best Fit, The FADER ymhlið dylanwadwyr eraill. Mae Amy wedi rhannu llwyfannau gyda phobl fel Kodaline ac Adam Melchor, mae wedi perfformio yng Ngŵyl Electric Picnic, Latitude (y DU) ac wedi cael ei dewis gan Gylchgrawn DIY fel artist addawol ar gyfer 2023. Mae mwy o ryddhau cerddoriaeth a mwy o sioeau byw ar y gorwel i amy eleni, un o artistiaid newydd mwyaf cyffrous y sîn yn Iwerddon.

amy michelle is a singer songwriter from Mullingar in the Irish midlands. Her deeply intimate songwriting and stunning voice caught the ears of the industry through her self-produced demos on Soundcloud in 2021. Since then amy has released two incredible EP's via UK record label Method records, both of which received wide acclaim from Clash, The Line Of Best Fit, The FADER among other tastemakers. amy has shared stages with the likes of Kodaline and Adam Melchor, performed at Electric Picnic Festival, Latitude (UK) and was picked by DIY Magazine as an artist to watch for 2023. More music releases and more live shows are ahead this year for amy, one of Ireland's most hotly tipped artists bubbling on the scene.



ANGHARAD

Genres: Pop, Spoken-word, Disco, Singer-songwriter, Experimental
Genres: Pop, Y gair llafar, Disgo, Cantores-gyfansoddwraig, Arbrofol

Angharad yw prosiect pop-amgen y gyfansoddwraig a'r ffidlwr Angharad Jenkins. A hithau'n artist pwerus, mentrus, mae ei cherddoriaeth newydd wedi ei chymharu â John Cale, PJ Harvey, Patti Smith a'u tebyg. Mae ei cherddoriaeth yn archwilio'r profiad benywaidd, mamolaeth, a'n perthynas ag amser.

Angharad is the alt-pop project of song-writer and fiddle player Angharad Jenkins. A powerful, and fearless artist, her new music has been drawing comparisons with the likes of John Cale, PJ Harvey, and Patti Smith. Her music explores the female experience, motherhood, and our relationship with time.



AUTUMNS

Genres: Post-punk, Electronic
Genres: Ôl-pync, Electronig

Mae Autumns yn cyflwyno ôl-pync electronig, wedi'i asio ag elfennau o dub a sain arbrofol. Mae'r prosiect yn dangos hoffter am rythmau sionc, lleisiau cryf a gitarau genre 'no wave', wedi'u prosesu trwy dechnegau dybio wrth y ddesg gymysgu. Mae obsesiwn â seiniau trawiadol yn arwain at sioe fyw llawn cyffro,

gan ddefnyddio cyn lleied â phosibl o gyfarpar i gael y canlyniadau gorau posibl.

Autumns is an outlet for electronic post-punk, fused with elements of dub and sound experimentation. The project showcases a love of whip-cracked rhythms, heavily effected vocals and no-wave guitars, processed through dub techniques within the mixing desk. An obsession with freak sounds leads to a high-intensity liveshow, using minimal equipment for maximum results.



CÁIT NÍ RAIN

Genre: Folk, Irish Folk
Genre: Gwerin, Gwerin Gwyddelig

Cantores sy'n chwarae offerynnau niferus o Tipperary yw Cáit Ní Riain. Mae hi wedi'i hysbrydoli'n fawr gan ganeuon alaw werin a cherddoriaeth ddawns lwerddon, yn ogystal â chael ei dylanwadu gan gerddoriaeth werin diwylliannau brodorol ledled y byd, cerddoriaeth sydd wedi ymwrreiddio yng nghyrff pobl sy'n byw mewn cytgord â'r tir.

Dr John Gallagher is Associate Professor of Early Modern History at the University of Leeds. Originally from Dublin, he is a historian of language and multilingualism, education, and migration. His first book, 'Learning Languages in Early Modern England', was published by Oxford University Press in 2019. John can often be heard presenting 'Free Thinking' on BBC Radio 3 and writes regularly for publications including the Guardian and the London Review of Books.


